Our winemaking team works with a family of growers to source a diverse variety of grapes from premier vineyards throughout California. The resulting wines are interesting blends of distinct quality and character.

ABOUT THE WINE

Syndrome is a force unto itself. Smart, resilient, adaptable. It grows like a vine and claims disciples—just like our wine. For Syndrome we combined red varietals from three outstanding growing regions: Calistoga, Napa Valley, and Carneros.

After harvest, the grapes were sent directly to the press. The press cut was taken at the color turn. The varietals were fermented in stainless steel at 55°F until dryness. After blending, the wine was bottled without fining.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Opens with aromas of watermelon, fresh strawberry, white peach, flowers, and a pleasing flintiness. Refreshing raspberry flavors follow with minerality leading to a bright, lingering finish.

THE BLEND

Grenache, Syrah, Pinot Noir, Sangiovese, and Mourvedre
